



Customer Measuring Guide

Measure your openings accurately to receive a more reliable estimate. If you are unsure, you can request a professional site measurement. The R450 measurement fee is credited against your final order value when you proceed with an order.

General Measuring Rules

1. Measure in millimetres (mm).
2. Measure width and height in three locations.
3. Use the smallest measurement recorded.
4. Record dimensions carefully.
5. Label each opening (e.g. Main Bedroom Window, Patio Door).

Windows

Measure:

- Width at top, middle and bottom.
- Height on left, centre and right.
- Use the smallest width and height.

Sliding Doors

Measure:

- Overall opening width.
- Overall opening height.
- Note whether the door slides left or right.
- Record any handles or obstructions.

French Doors & Patio Doors

Measure:

- Overall width across both door leaves.
- Overall height of opening.
- Note door swing direction.

Example Recording Schedule

Main Bedroom Window – 1200mm × 1500mm

Lounge Sliding Door – 2400mm × 2100mm

Patio Door – 1800mm × 2100mm
